

#Cidadania

The #Cidadania is a project coordinated by Associação Mais Cidadania (AMC) which aims to **promote Civic Education** through **non-formal education methodologies**.

In Portugal, the interest of young people in politics has been successively decreasing, which leads them to often feel poorly represented by their governments. However, this does not necessarily translate into a lack of interest in citizenship topics. The uninterrupted use of technological means and connections in their daily lives leads young people to create their own ecosystem of participation and get involved in actions and campaigns generated and led by their peers.

#Cidadania project aims to take advantage of these spaces of youth participation to promote democratic initiative and active citizenship in the public, social and individual life. With this, we hope to contribute to the recognition of citizenship as a practice of added value for the lives of young people.

To achieve this it is intended to train young people and citizenship educators (teachers, mediators, psychologist, youth workers) to develop in these spaces actions and contents that assist learning about, through, and for citizenship. It is in this context that **#Citizenship: Human Rights Training** appears. This **training will be hosted by the Norwegian partner “Human Rights Academy”** and has a total duration of **8 hours, divided in 4 on line sessions**. The trainees that participate in all sessions will receive a certificate of participation and the manual "Conectados pela #CIDADANIA" (guide for technicians who work with young people to promote citizenship and Human Rights).

This project is part of the “[programa Cidadãos Ativ@s](#)”, a component of the EEA Grants programme which aims to support non-governmental organisations. The programme is funded by Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway, and is managed in Portugal by the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation in consortium with the Bissaya Barreto Foundation.

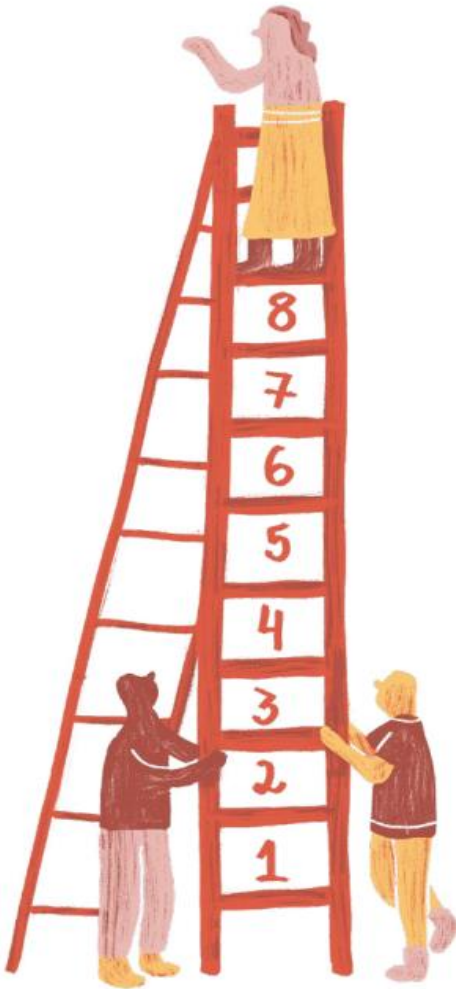
